**Math Buddies** is a program for children in grades 1 to 6 who have difficulty with math or who require additional practice working with mathematical concepts. Children will be paired with a high school volunteer and they will spend time together working on math activities and worksheets, and playing fun math-based games.

High school volunteers can earn up to 10 hours toward their community service while making a valuable contribution to the life of a child. It is also fun!

**The Sessions:**

Math Buddies pairs will meet in the library once a week for a one hour session; the sessions continue for ten weeks. Sessions can take place any time that the library is open. Meeting times must be mutually agreed upon by both the teen volunteer and the child's parent(s).
